ACTION UNDER DELEGATED AUTHORITY OF DIRECTOR OF FINANCE

<p>PROJECT:</p> <p>Cedars Park - 10% Council contribution towards lake restoration works (Heritage Lottery Funded)</p> <hr/> <p>Cedars Park has been awarded a Heritage Lottery fund grant of £68,000 after a successful application was made by the Friends of Cedars Park.</p> <p>The grant will help to establish a number of projects to improve the space, protect the local habitat and provide opportunities for families to experience local wildlife. The pond and water was a key feature of Theobald's Palace over 400 years ago and the project will include installing a sustainable filtration system to help maintain water quality, and a pond-dipping station.</p> <p>A new nature trail, based around the refurbished pond, will work in conjunction with a specially created digital app, making information about the history and wildlife of the area easily accessible to visitors.</p> <p>The Friends of Cedars Park have reintroduced the native honey bee to the park after a 100 year absence. Part of the grant will go towards planting native and historical plant species to support and create a habitat for bees, endangered bats, grass snakes and other local species.</p>
