APPROVAL FOR ALLOCATION OF S106 FUNDS TO A PROJECT
ACTION UNDER DELEGATED AUTHORITY OF DIRECTOR OF FINANCE
(Cabinet Minute 8: 2016)

<p>PROJECT:</p> <p>It has been brought to the attention of the Community Safety Team that due to a number of influencing factors, there is limited CCTV in Cheshunt Old Pond at the present time.</p> <p>The wireless router that serves Laura Trott Leisure Centre and Tesco car park has been disconnected since the demolition of Wolsey Hall. This has led to a number of cameras in the location not working. To install a wireless router in this area would cost £1,125.</p> <p>Furthermore, during maintenance work carried out by HCC, a lamppost has been removed in Turners Hill that homed a further wireless router to the Community Hospital. This has led to a further 3 cameras without a link to the WX hub. The cost to fix this issue would be £2,390</p> <p>The cameras cover a number of the Council's car parks as well as provide CCTV coverage to the Old Pond. The World Cup Football Championships are due to commence in June this year and because one of the main reasons for the initial installation of CCTV in this location was to deal with any potential disorder during previous events, it is recommended that these cameras are fully operational.</p>
